

CABINET MEETING COMMUNIQUE
MEETING OF FEBRUARY 16, 2007

- The Cabinet, in deliberation with guests at the meeting, considered the matter of student housing for the Fall Semester 2007. Following a discussion that took into consideration projected student housing needs for next fall, the Cabinet determined that the following dormitories should be made available to house students at that time: Varnado (Honors: GPA of 3.0 or higher); Boozman; and Sabine.
- Mr. Sampite asked that consideration be given to converting Bossier Hall into a warehouse and a facility to house custodial workers.
- The group discussed means by which the University might reasonably comply with a requirement by Rich Griswold of the Board of Regents staff that construction of new student housing for apartment-style living include at least 100 square feet per bedroom. Dr. Stacy will research this further, but a decision must be made next week.
- Mr. Sampite reported on projects planned for this summer.
