

CABINET MEETING COMMUNIQUE
MEETING OF APRIL 1, 2008

Present: Crew, Dr. Steve Horton vice Dr. Tom Hanson, Carl Jones, Marcus Jones, Pierce, Webb, Williams

- Dr. Webb shared information from the March meeting of the Board of Supervisors, including matters pertaining to the current Regular Session of the Legislature.
- Mr. Crew indicated the University will move from parking hang tags to decals for next year due to security matters.
- Dr. Horton reported on the progress of new degree programs proposed by the University and others under consideration for presentation.
- The Cabinet voted to approve a distributive system for copying, scanning, and faxing letters and related documents for the following groups of campus offices: Graduate Studies and Scholarships; Financial Aid; Registrar, Alumni, and Recruiting.
- Carl Jones informed the group that none of the vendors seeking to operate the University Bookstore submitted a proposal consistent with requirements of the RFP. A second, revised RFP has now been disseminated and the deadline for responses is set for April 30.
